RE BROADCAST BYRNES ORDERS STRICT CEILINGS ON LABOR TO BOOST WAR OUTPUT. MANPOWER LIMITS APPLY TO WAR PLANTS AND CIVILIAN INDUSTRY IN SHORTAGE AREAS. TWO MAJOR PROVISIONS OF BYRNES DIRECTIVE FIRST BASED UPON REQUIREMENTS FOR ESSENTIAL PRODUCTION AND SERVICES DETERMINED BY AREA PRODUCTION URGENCY COMMITTEES, THE MANPOWER PRIORITIES COMMITTEE SHALL ESTABLISH EMPLOYMENT CEILINGS IN WAR INDUSTRIES TO ENFORCE BETTER UTILIZATION OF EXISTING LABOR. IT SHALL ESTABLISH CEILINGS IN LESS ESSENTIAL INDUSTRIES. IT SHALL SET MANPOWER PRIORITIES AND OTHER MEASURES NECESSARY TO INSURE PROPER AND FULL UTILIZATION OF EXISTING MANPOWER SECOND AREA PRODUCTION URGENCY COMMITTEES AND MANPOWER PRIORITIES COMMITTEES SHALL BE ESTABLISHED IN GROUPS AND LABOR AREAS. THE AREA PRODUCTION URGENCY COMMITTEES ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR AUTHORIZING INCREASED CIVILIAN PRODUCTION. NO INCREASED CIVILIAN PRODUCTION WILL BE AUTHORIZED IN AREA WITHOUT APPROVED OF THIS COMMITTEE AND MUST HAVE AUTHORIZATION OF WMC REPRESENTATIVE WITHIN AREA TO EFFECT THAT LABOR IS AVAILABLE FOR SUCH PRODUCTION WITHOUT INTERFERENCE WITH LOCAL LABOR RECRUITING EFFORTS STOP ORDER HITS AT MIGRATION FROM WAR INDUSTRY OF WORKERS NOW SEEING PEACE IN THE OFFING WHO ARE ATTEMPTING TO GET RELOCATED STOP RESPONSIBILITY FOR MANNING WAR
